Simply lie down and enjoy spending time looking up at the clouds and see what shapes you can see.


Use your imagination (and it might help to squint a bit!) and tell your friends or family what the cloud shapes look like to you.

Latin words are used to describe what clouds are like. These words are used together to make names for different types of cloud e.g. nimbostratus or altocumulus

Alto

means clouds at medium altitude (height in the sky)

Nimbus

means rain-bearing
