





You don't need a telescope. On a clear night there is a lot that can be seen with the naked eye.

Somewhere dark without two many tall buildings or streetlights nearby, a garden chair or cushion to sit on, blankets to keep warm, and a torch to read your notes.

A compass is useful to know which direction you are facing. You may also like to use some binoculars to see the stars in more detail.

Top Tip: Use a red bicycle light to read your Star Guide without affecting your night vision. You could adapt a normal torch using red
